

Downtown Westminster – Going Mobile

How the suburbs are experiencing a transportation transformation

Mobility helps us get around the world, as the City of Westminister recognizes for its Downtown core. Located in the center of Westminister, the 105-acre Downtown Westminister site is well situated along key transportation corridors. The site is directly adjacent to the RTD US 36 & Sheridan Station, with 498 buses a day and direct non-stop access to Denver's Union Station. A future station for the B Line/Northwest Rail is planned for the southern edge of the site. The US 36 Bikeway runs along the eastern edge of the Downtown, making the site a crossroads for multiple modes of mobility. However, pedestrian connections, safe crossings, and transit priority are all challenging in the Downtown area. With the Downtown poised to become a key destination for employment, residents, and visitors with over 6,500,000 square feet of development at build out, creating an environment that is easily accessed and safe is key to the City.

The City of Westminister conducted a mobility and transportation analysis that specifically addressed arterials and intersections accessing the Downtown. Significant transformations of 92nd Avenue, 88th Avenue, and Harlan Street are planned to enhance mobility for all.

Come join Westminister staff on a walking tour of the Downtown followed by a presentation of their mobility plans for the surrounding area and happy hour at the Kokopelli Beer Company. Hear about key challenges, thoughtful solutions, and next steps toward implementation.
